APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL:

These instructions apply to the 2010 AWRP Scholarship Program Applications.

You will notice that the application has two general sections. The first page is a request for personal information as well as the name of your sponsor company. The committee to evaluate applicants will NOT use information on this first section.

The next pages are a request for your Educational and Community Service Background and essays on your educational goals, plans and leadership. This section will be evaluated by the Scholarship Committee and will be the basis for awarding the scholarships.

The Scholarship Committee will choose from blind applications. Scholarships must be claimed within 12 months after receipt of the awarded scholarship.

AWARDS:

Six \$3000 scholarships will be awarded between August 15th and September 1st. Scholarship checks will go directly to the school of the applicant's choice.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for an award, you must be:

- A current employee or child of a current employee of an AWRP member company in the United States and Canada (all classes of membership are included).
- Any person planning to attend college/university this fall full-time. Planning to obtain a degree at an accredited 2-year or 4-year college or university.
- Registered or planning to register as a "full-time" student as defined by the college or university.

Children of scholarship committee members are NOT eligible.

A maximum of ONE scholarship per company will be awarded.
