APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL:

These instructions apply to the **2026** AWRF Scholarship Program application process.

You will notice that the application has two general sections. The first page is a request for personal information as well as the name of your sponsor company.

PLEASE NOTE: The committee to evaluate applicants will NOT be given the first page, but the information is required so that we may be able to administer the application throughout the process.

The next pages are a request for your Educational and Community Service background and essays on your educational goals, plans and leadership. This section will be evaluated by the Scholarship Committee and will be the basis for awarding the scholarships.

The Scholarship Committee will choose from blind applications. Scholarships must be applied within the current school/college year.

AWARDS:

Twelve (12) \$3,500 scholarships will be awarded at the end of August. The scholarship checks will go directly to the school of the applicant's choice.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Eligibility is limited to current employees of an AWRF Member Company, as well as their spouse or dependent(s), residing in the United States or Canada. All classes of membership are included.
- To be eligible for this award, you must be planning to attend a college/university for the 2026/2027 school year and planning to obtain a degree at an accredited 2-year or 4-year college or university.

An applicant may win no more than **one** (1) scholarship in their lifetime.

A maximum of **one** (1) scholarship per company location or branch per year will be awarded.
