KEYNOTE: Jason Chaffetz



Former Congressman Jason Chaffetz is a Fox News contributor and author of the New York Times bestsellers *Power Grab: The Liberal Scheme to Undermine Trump, The GOP and Our Republic* and *The Deep State: How an Army of Bureaucrats Protected Barack Obama and Is Working to Destroy the Trump Agenda*.

Chaffetz was elected to Congress in 2008 and served until 2017. He was selected by his peers to be a Chairman of the powerful Oversight & Government Reform Committee, where he led investigations into the United States Secret Service, the Department of Education I.T. vulnerabilities, the Drug Enforcement Agency, the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) data breach, the Environmental Protection Agency, the Benghazi terrorist attack, *Fast & Furious* and the IRS scandal.

Prior to Congress, he was Chief of Staff to the Governor of Utah. A former place kicker on the Brigham Young University Football Team, he earned his BA in Communications in 1989 and then joined the local business community for 16 years before entering the public sector.

NETWORKING GOLF TOURNAMENT

Riverwinds Golf and Tennis Club



The golf course at RiverWinds stays true to the heritage of historic courses in Scotland and Ireland. Nestled in the grasslands between scenic Woodbury Creek and the deep harbor marina on the Delaware River, The 18 hole championship course invokes visions of seaside golf. The water, surrounding wetlands and mile-long twisting burn create an intriguing setting. Across the water are breathtaking views of Philadelphia's skyline. RiverWinds provides a challenge for the best player; with five sets of tees, golfers of all skill levels enjoy the course. At the start, the mounded terrain is gentle, but becomes gradually more imposing as play progresses. The holes vary in direction, requiring players to use every club in their bag to battle the crosswinds and the tough terrain. Other natural landforms, indigenous foliage and sod-walled bunkers add to the excitement of the golf experience at RiverWinds.

This 7,086-yard, par 72 course was designed by architect Ed Shearon and shaped by expert Pete Fazio, of the renowned golfing family. This original course brings world-class golf to the Philadelphia area. Voted one of the "Best Places to Play" in New Jersey by Golf Week

His three sons, Washington, Ferdinand, and Charles built their father's company into the world's leading producer of wire rope with four factories and nearly 8,000 employees at its peak.
